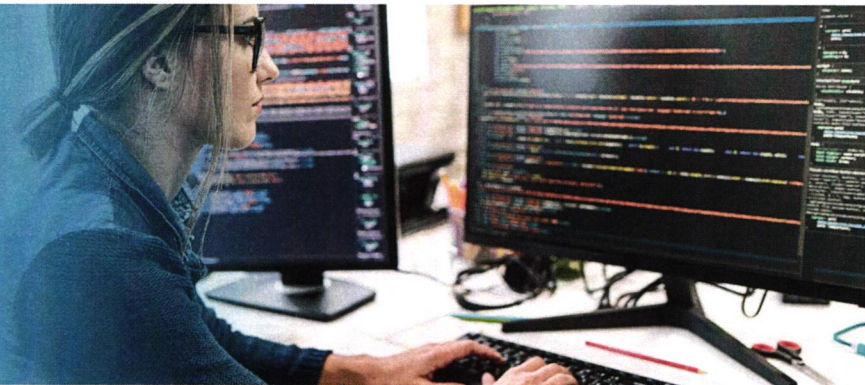




# Ohioans Can Enroll in Training and Earn a Credential at No Cost

## Individual Microcredential Assistance Program (IMAP)

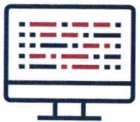
The Individual Microcredential Assistance Program (IMAP) helps Ohioans participate in a training program to receive a credential at no cost.



### OVERVIEW

IMAP providers offer training for over 80 different tech-focused credentials – many of which can be completed 100% online, meaning location is not a barrier.

IMAP training providers will cover all tuition, fees, and additional costs (up to \$3,000) to help you learn new skills and earn a credential that can lead to a good job.

### WHO CAN ENROLL?

To participate, you must be an Ohio resident. Students in high school are eligible if they are entering their junior or senior year. Incarcerated individuals are eligible if they are eligible for release within 12 months.

Individual training programs may have additional requirements.
